These books are a gift and we want the children to feel that they are worth something special. We also request books that represent a diverse population. We serve a large number of African American and Hispanic families and are always in need of books sensitive to these cultures. <u>We need soft backed picture books</u> except for the board books for very small children. Below are some suggestions of popular titles, subjects and authors to choose from. If you could also donate a large envelope in which to mail the book and \$3-4 to cover the postage, we would be very grateful. Our biggest needs now are for soft covered storybooks for 3-6 year olds and board books for the very small.

Board books for ages birth – 3 years

Picture Books – ages 3-8

Please choose books that are colorful. Look for award winners and stories that are culturally diverse.

Beginning Readers – ages 4-8

Favorite series...Henry & Mudge, Fly Guy, Biscuit, Cam Jansen, and Minnie & Moo. Staff at a book store can also help you locate great nonfiction titles for beginning readers.

Spanish/Bi-Lingual

Many children's favorites are translated into Spanish. Please be sensitive about choosing books that show children of Spanish heritage.
